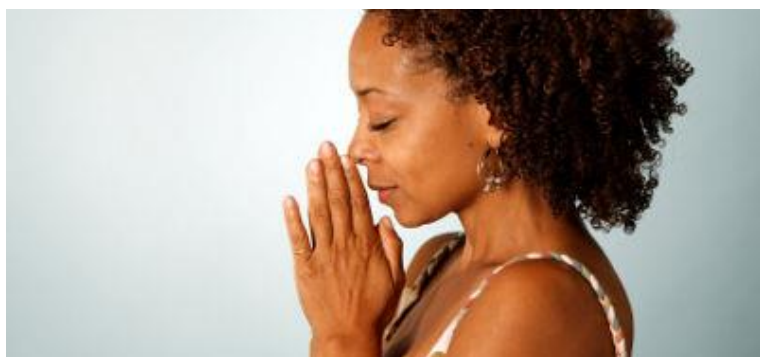
Fill them with the knowledge of Your will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding, that they may walk worthy of You and be fully pleasing to You.

How Do You Know?

And a husband is not to divorce his wife...: If any brother has a wife who does not believe, and she is willing to live with him, let him not divorce her. And a woman who has a husband who does not believe, if he

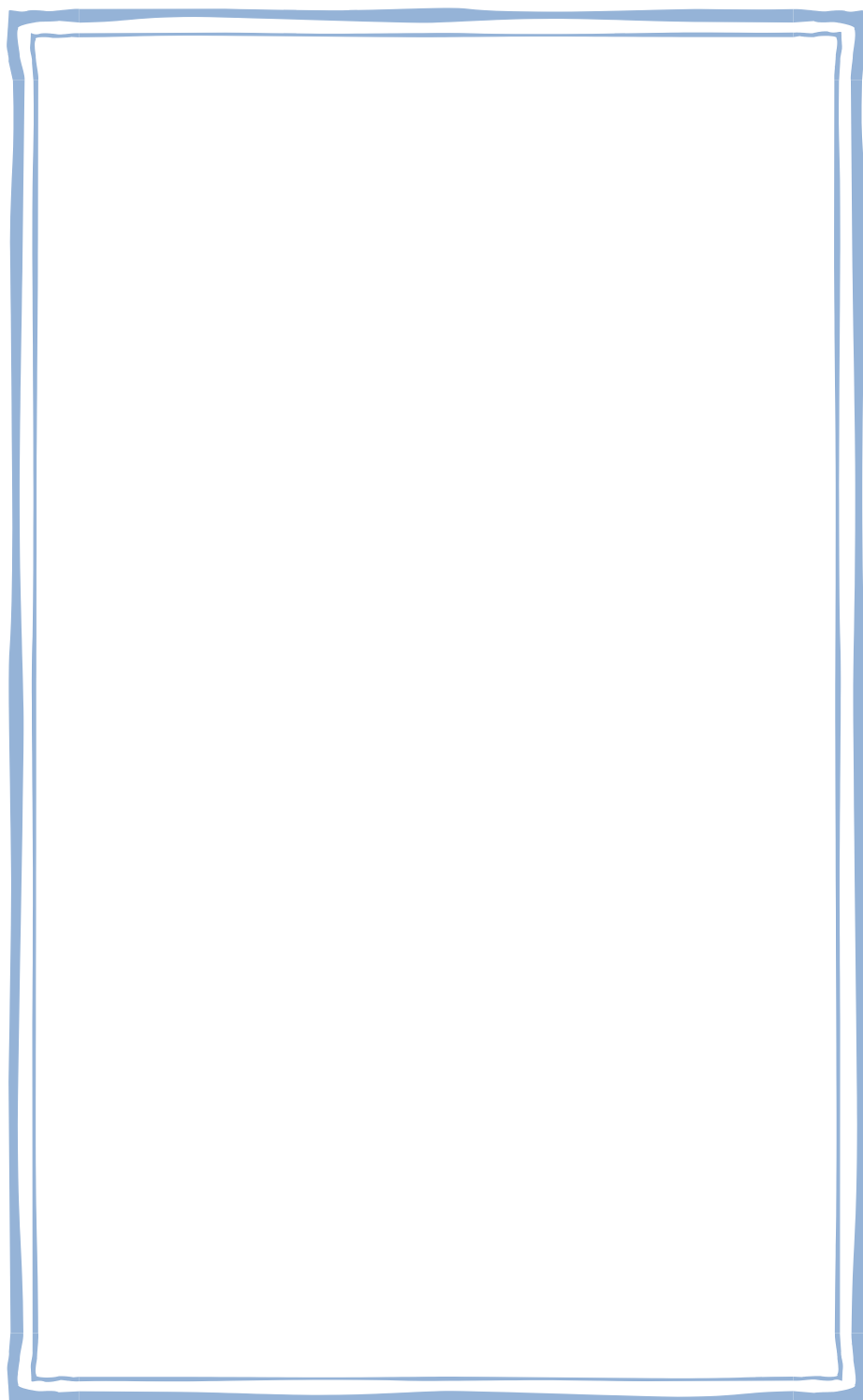

For the unbelieving husband is sanctified by the wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified by the husband; otherwise your children would be unclean, but now they are holy. But if the unbeliever departs, let him depart; a brother or a sister is not under bondage in such cases. But God has called us to peace.
