Acts 2:46, So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart.

Romans 12:4-5, For as we have many members in one body, but all the members do not have the same function, so we, *being* many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another.

Quote: "If you want to go fast, go alone. If you want to go far, go together.”

1 Corinthians 12:18, But now God has set the members, each one of them, in the body just as He pleased.

We are His children and He places us in a Huge Body - The Church; and specific bodies - the local church; and smaller bodies as members of one another.

In Christ’s Body We Are: Interdependent with one another.

Digital Age Generation:

1 Corinthians 12:21, And the eye cannot say to the hand, “I have no need of you”; nor again the head to the feet, “I have no need of you.”

In Christ’s Body We Are: Humble with one another.

1 Corinthians 12:25 (NIV), so that there should be no division in the body, but that its parts should have equal concern for each other.

In Christ’s Body We Are: Unified with one another.
